### CLARENDON HILLS

In the state of South Australia, near Adelaide, a unique winery produces single varietal, single vineyard wines. The extraordinary quality can be attributed to the age of the vines, many of the dry-farmed and hand harvested vineyards are over 70 years old! The wines are bottled unfiltered and unfinned to capture the unique expression of the vineyard and varietal. The Brookman Vineyard Merlot is opulent with blueberry, mulberry and chocolate overtones, while the Blewitt Springs Grenache is deeply colored with upfront raspberry fruit and firm tannins. The Sandown Cabernet exhibits a muscular structure and a powerful mid-palate of rich cassis and black currant flavors and the Bakers Gully Syrah displays a generous core of cherries and red currant with a focused finish. Enjoy these limited production gems.

### SPANISH WHITES

Spain produces some of the best food pairing wines on the planet that also offer outstanding value. All are crisp, medium-bodied and unoaked. While sauvignon blanc is familiar to most, the Spanish rendition retains the crisp acidity characteristic of the varietal and adds some tropical notes. Albarino exhibits ultra high acidity and intense minerality which makes it the perfect complement to pure seafood dishes. On the palate verdejo displays bright stone fruit and viura (the main white grape of Rioja, also known as macabeo) is light and versatile with fresh lemon nuances.

### SOUTH AMERICA

Wines from the two major production countries of Chile and Argentina represent a unique dynamic from the continent. Although each produce distinct, local grapes, the whites tend to have a floral characteristic in common and the reds are intense and full-bodied. Sauvignon blanc results in a highly aromatic, zesty version of the popular crisp varietal. Torrontes is gaining in popularity with low acidity, peach and apricot flavors. Malbec remains the king of the reds in Argentina with dark fruits dominant. Blending several grape species often results in more complexity than single varietal wines.

The Quatro consists of malbec, cabernet sauvignon, carmenère & syrah.
